ICJ orders Israel to halt Rafah offensive

JUDGES AT THE top United Nations court ordered Israel on Friday to halt its military assault on the southern Gaza city of Rafah, in a landmark emergency ruling on South Africa's case accusing Israel of genocide.

Reading out the ruling by the International Court of Justice (ICJ) or World Court, the body's president Nawaf Salam said the situation in the Palestinian enclave had deteriorated since the court last ordered Israel to take steps to improve it. Conditions had been met for a new emergency order.

"The state of Israel shall (...) immediately halt its military offensive, and any other action in the Rafah governorate, which may inflict on the Palestinian group in Gaza conditions of life that could bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part," he said.

The court also ordered Israel to open the Rafah crossing between Egypt and Gaza to allow in humanitarian aid, and said it must provide access to the besieged enclave for inves-

tigators and report back on its progress within one month. The order was adopted by the panel of 15 judges from around the world in a 13-2 vote, opposed only by judges from Uganda and from Israel itself.

It was handed down a week after it was requested by South Africa as part of a case accusing Israel of genocide.

The ICJ is the highest UN body for hearing disputes between states. Its rulings are final and binding but have

been ignored in the past. The court has no enforcement powers. Outside, a small group of pro-Palestinian demonstrators waved flags and played a rap on a boom box calling for a free Palestine.

Israel has repeatedly dismissed the case's accusations of genocide as baseless, arguing in court that its operations in Gaza are self-defence and targeted at Hamas militants who attacked Israel on October 7.

IMF, Pakistan make crucial progress on new loan

AN INTERNATIONAL MONETARY Fund (IMF) mission and Pakistan have made significant progress towards reaching a staff-level agreement for an extended fund facility, the global lender said on Friday.

The IMF has opened discussions with Pakistan on a new loan programme after Islamabad last month completed a short-term \$3 billion programme, which helped stave off a sovereign debt default.

An IMF team, led by mission chief Nathan Porter, concluded discussions with the authorities on Thursday after arriving in Pakistan on May 13, the lender said in a statement. "The mission and the authorities will continue policy discussions virtually over the coming days aiming to finalise discussions, including the financial support needed to underpin the authorities' reform efforts from the IMF and Pakistan's bilateral and multi-lateral partners," Porter said.

The IMF's comments helped the benchmark share index scale a record high and breach the key 76,000 level. The index was last up 1.2%.

EU urges US to pass new tech rules

THE EUROPEAN UNION'S (EU) industry chief has called on the United States to pass new technology regulations, in the hopes of fostering a cohesive digital marketplace across the Atlantic.

The EU is widely considered a leading authority in tech regulation, having passed sweeping pieces of legislation scrutinising the practices of major companies like Google and Meta, including the Digital

Markets Act (DMA) and the Artificial Intelligence (AI) Act. The US has largely relied on existing legislation to regulate the tech giants' business practices.

For example, in March the Department of Justice filed an antitrust lawsuit against Apple, alleging the iPhone maker had broken established monopoly rules. Apple rejected this claim, and has asked a judge

to dismiss the suit. "We need the same digital regulation. It would be fantastic to have a global digital market. Not only EU, not only US, but EU and US," Thierry Breton said.

Amid a public outcry over the potential risks of rapidly-advancing AI systems, US President Joe Biden last year rolled out a number of AI-focused executive orders, requiring

developers to put their systems through safety tests, and introducing guidelines to help root out deepfake images.

"It's extremely important we align now," Breton added. "We share the same values in the US and in Europe, and it would be fantastic."

Breton was speaking at the annual "Viva Technology" conference in Paris, where leading tech executives and political figures such as ex-Google CEO Eric Schmidt and former US climate envoy John Kerry took to the stage this year.
